- Goal 1: The percentage of seniors completing a FASFA will be 90% in 2020-2021 school year
 - All Seniors will be provided two opportunities to complete FASFA during a face to face support session provided by the University of Texas of the Permian Basin.
 - All live sessions will be recorded and accessible on UTPB STEM Academy webpage for virtual learners.
 - January FASFA and ApplyTX webinar and individual sessions through UTPB
 - April STEM Senior Signing date

- **COMPONENT 1:** Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Criteria in ELA/Reading and Mathematics. Graduates meeting the college-ready criteria on the TSIA, SAT, ACT, or by completing and earning credit for a college prep course in both ELA and math.

- **COMPONENT 2:** Meet Criteria on Advanced Placement (AP) with a score of 3 or more. [Report Column: AP Met](#)

OR

- **COMPONENT 3:** Earn Dual Course Credits. A graduate completing and earning credit for at least 3 credit hours in ELA or math or at least 9 credit hours in any subject.

- **COMPONENT 4:** Enlist in the Armed Forces. [Report Column: MIL ENL](#)

OR

- **COMPONENT 5:** Earn an Industry-Based Certification. [Report Column: IND CRT](#)

- **COMPONENT 6:** Earn an Associate's Degree. [Report Column: ASC DEG](#)

- **COMPONENT 7:** Graduate with Completed Individualized Education Program (IEP), which includes graduation type codes :04, 05, 54, or 55. [Report Column: GRAD IEP](#)

OR

- **COMPONENT 10:** Graduate under an Advanced Degree Plan and be identified as a current Special Education Student. [Report Column: ADP SPED](#)

- **COMPONENT 11:** Earn a Level I or Level II Certificate in any workforce education.
